Useful information for your stay at the centre CAES du CNRS – La Vieille Perrotine on l'île d'Oléron

Arrival:

In case of a bus transfer from the train station, we are open until the arrival of the bus to give the keys of the room.

If you come by your own way in public services (Line 7 from La Rochelle, 6 from Rochefort or 6E from Surgères), you have to get off at the bus stop Dolus d'Oléron located at 5 km from our centre. Please ask several days in advance if you need a ride to reach our place.

Late arrival: after the closing of the reception, the keys can be left at your disposal at the bar or with the seminar organizer. The explanations can be found on the main door of the reception.


A car park is available at the entrance of the centre

Bus transfer from La Rochelle station:

The bus can be found at the other side of the station, you have to go across the train track, see map below.



Rooms:

- bed made up
- 2 towels + 1 bath mat provided
- shower gel + shampoo + soap provided
- cleaning will be done by our cleaning team at the end of your stay (we invite you to remove your bed sheets and put them on the floor in the living room. Please gather your dirty towels in the bath room)
- the check-out of the room is before 9 am

In an earth friendly gesture, we don't change the towels every day.

- 2 nights stay: we don't change towels
- 3 to 5 nights stay: we change the towels after the second or the third night
- 6 to 7 nights stay: we change the towels after the second and the fourth night

We only change the bed sheet for one week stay or more. Bathroom, toilet and kitchen will be cleaned when the towels are changed.

Clean towels, shower gel, toilet paper etc... are available on demand at the reception. There is no WIFI, nor TV in the rooms. A free WIFI network is available on the « Îlot central » at the bar, restaurant and workspaces, the code is oleronyp17310

Activities at the centre:

- -The swimming pool is open from April to September and heated only in July/August. Boardshorts are forbidden.
- -There is a direct access to the beach located in the natural reserve Moëze-Oléron, you can swim when the tide is high.
- -Free bikes with padlock are provided during your stay. A time slot will be given for your group
- -We have a direct access to a cycle path to go to Boyardvillle and from the main beach, you can see the famous Fort Boyard.
- -Kayaks are in self-service on our lake
- -We have multi-sports terrains: tennis, pétanque, volleyball, football, basketball and ping-pong. We can provide balls, rackets...
- -We have a media library with books and board games
- -Sailing activities are available at sea near Boyardville, from April to September on demand to the seminar organizer

The centre is located in the middle of swamps, meaning that we could have a lot of mosquitoes, we advise you to take repellent spray with you.
